### CLASS DRESS CODE

Ballet and Pointe Classes- All female ballet students must wear the color of leotard specified for their class along with pink ballet tights, and pink canvas ballet slippers. Hair must be neatly pulled back into a tight bun. All male ballet students must wear white shirts, black pants/tights, and black socks with black canvas ballet shoes.

Cherub- Pink leotard

Preballet- Pink leotard

Intro Ballet- Light blue leotard

Low Intermediate- Burgundy leotard

Intermediate- Navy leotard

Prep 1- Lavender leotard

Prep 2- White leotard

Junior- Royal blue and Marine blue leotards

Senior- Eggplant and Black leotards

Tap, Jazz, Contemporary, Modern, and Jazz Funk classes- Students wear black leotards, black tights, and black pants/capris. Tap wears black tap shoes. Contemporary and modern are bare feet. Jazz and jazz funk wear tan jazz shoes.

Acro/tumbling classes wear leotard, shorts, bare feet, and hair pulled back off the face.

### CLASS ETIQUETTE AND GUIDELINES

Arrive 5-10 minutes before class.

Use the dressing rooms store your belongings.

Be properly dressed for class. See dress code.

No jewelry.

Hair must be neatly pulled back in a bun.

Use the restroom and get drinks before class.

No talking, gum, or hanging on the barres.

Please do not touch the mirrors.

Wear your dance shoes only for dance in the classroom, never outside.

No street shoes allowed on the dance floor.
