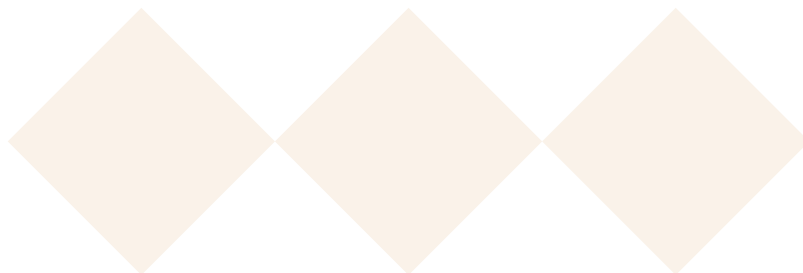

GALA REMINDERS

- You may park anywhere you find parking downtown. Parking passes for the Flagler College lot will be available and you will be notified via email about when and how to purchase them.
- Please label all shoes, bags, costumes, etc
- With your dance supplies, you may also want to bring water and extra supplies like tights.
- Please keep all of your belongings in a compact bag.
- Hair and makeup should be completely done before arriving at the theater.
- Dancers with costume changes **MUST** have a nude-leotard that is worn underneath at all times.
- Dads will not be allowed into the women's dressing rooms.

GALA FAQS

1) When and where will the 2026 Gala take place?

June 6th 2026

2) How do I purchase tickets for the 2026 Galas?

Tickets will be available for purchase on our website at dancesadc.com. Gala tickets are \$15-20 per ticket.

3) What should my child wear for rehearsal and the show?

Students should arrive to the theater with hair and makeup done and wearing their costume, tights with no holes, and clean shoes. If they have multiple costumes they will need to be wearing a nude leotard. Please refer to prior pages for more information.

4) What day/time is my child's rehearsal?

All rehearsals will take place at Lewis Auditorium prior to the doors opening for the actual show. Please find the time of your child's rehearsal on the Dancer Call Blocks page of the Gala Handbook.

5) How long are the 2026 Galas?

Gala 1: 1hr, no intermission

Gala 2: 1hr 15 min., no intermission

Gala 3: 1hr 30min + 10 min intermission

6) How and where do I drop off my dancer?

You should Check In with our staff at the Stage Door. Please walk your dancer to this door located on the west side of the facility facing the south side of the gymnasium. You will receive a card with their name on it which you will then present when you pickup your dancer at Check Out.

7) What does my dancer do the whole time?

At Check In, they will be escorted to their dressing room where volunteer Class Moms will watch them for the duration of their time back stage. They will be taken to the auditorium to rehearse their dance and then return to their dressing room in time for doors to open for the Gala performance. They will be guided every step of the way through the show experience and will be ready to pickup at the Stage Door after the performance.

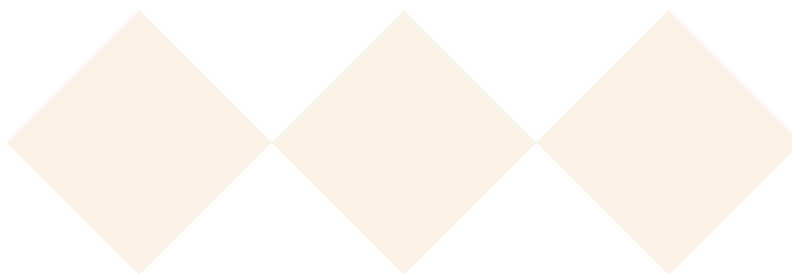

It takes an army to make such a special weekend at the Gala Weekend! You will receive a **Signup Genius in your email**. Please **Work-One See-One** and volunteer for one of the many important positions available. Your help allows others to enjoy, as others are helping to make sure you enjoy!

if you are not the listed to volunteer, you may drop off your dancer at the check in table.

- Arrive at your dancer's Dancer Call Time listed on the schedule.
- Check in at the Stage Door where you will receive a card with your dancer's name. You will return the card at Check Out after the performance.
- Rehearsals are closed to parents and families.
- Our Staff and Volunteers will help your dancer get to the dressing room, monitor their time there, and ensure their travel between the dressing room and the stage or auditorium.
- Dancers performing in Act 2 will sit assigned seating in the audience for Act 1. Dancers performing in Act 1 will sit assigned seating in the audience for Act 2.
